

Residential Family Rooms

Residential Venue

This year's residential will take place at the University of Warwick from Tuesday 21 July to Thursday 23 July 2026. Participants are expected to arrive on Monday 20 July and depart on Thursday 23 July. Frontline will cover the cost of accommodation and meals for those staying in student accommodation on campus.

Accommodation for Families

Participants who book family accommodation will need to cover the full cost of their stay and any caregiving arrangements. However, Frontline will reimburse up to £57 per night - the equivalent cost of a standard on-campus room.

A limited number of family rooms are available on campus at Scarman and Radcliffe, offered on a first-come, first-served basis. **If you plan to bring your child, please note that accommodation must be arranged independently.** As of May 2026, the rate for family rooms is £125 + VAT per night (subject to change based on availability), and this includes accommodation and breakfast.

Rooms can be configured with the following options:

- Single pull-out bed
- Double pull-out bed
- Z-bed
- A limited number of cots (subject to availability; bedding not provided)

Children aged 12 and under stay free of charge. For any additional guests (aged 13+), a fee of £25 + VAT per night applies.

If you plan to book your own family accommodation, **please notify us in advance so we are aware and can ensure that no student accommodation is reserved for you.**

When submitting your query, please select the relevant query category. You will then see a Readiness for Pactive (RfP) option appear — please ensure you select this, so your receipts and/or query are directed to the correct team.

Please note that meals provided by Frontline during teaching days (including lunch and dinner) are for participants only. Any meals for family members or guests will need to be arranged and covered independently.

Childcare (Nursery)

If you plan to bring a child of nursery age and require childcare, you can arrange this directly with the on-site University of Warwick Nursery (subject to availability):

Alternative Accommodation Options: Hotels

If no suitable rooms are available on campus, alternative accommodation can be arranged at nearby hotels close to the teaching venue. Some examples of nearby hotels are noted below.

Nearby Hotels

1. Holiday Inn Coventry M6, Jct.2
 - o Distance from University of Warwick: Approximately 2 miles
2. Premier Inn Coventry City Centre Belgrade Plaza
 - o Distance from University of Warwick: Approximately 4 miles
3. Ibis Coventry Centre
 - o Distance from University of Warwick: Approximately 4 miles
4. Britannia Coventry Hill Hotel
 - o Distance from University of Warwick: Approximately 3 miles

Please note that prices may vary depending on factors such as availability and booking time, so it's advisable to check current rates and availability directly with the hotels or through online booking platforms.
